Dear Mr. Dorner:

I have received your request and must respectfully decline for the following reasons:

1. At the deposition of M.s Dorner which occurred on April 21, 2017, it was first disclosed by her that she had contact with me months before you retained my services to help you in your divorce. Please remember that you were referred to me by a mutual friend.

2. The deposition was stopped. You and I both then drafted declarations regarding these events. We both attend and ex parte hearing at which time this issue was discussed. The outcome of that hearing was that the Court would hear any potential recusal motion filed by Ms. Jach is she decided to do so.

You were aware of this issue on April 21, 2017, and yet between that date, and the message I received from you yesterday, you never raised the issue. We then had a meeting on June 16, 2017 and at that meeting I proposed that you needed to come up with a plan in order for our professional relationship to continue. I proposed a deadline for a response by the 5:00 p.m. on the following Monday.

When I received no response, I sent the following email:

As you know, during our meeting on Friday June 16, I asked that you propose a plan in order for this case to move forward in a positive manner. I expressed my concerns that you are not accepting my advice as to how to resolve this matter, and that you insist on pursuing litigation which, in my opinion, based upon my year of experience practicing family law in San Diego County, is not in your best interest. Unsurprisingly, we have not been able to obtain the results you desired. You then seek to blame me for not achieving the results that you desired. This situation is untenable because you seek to control all aspects of litigation, despite my counsel. I requested that you provide guidance and a plan to move forward by close of business on Monday, June 19.

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I voluntarily extended the response time to noon on Tuesday, June 20. When there was no response, I informed you that I would begin the process of copying your file and would have it ready by 3:00 p.m. on Friday, June 23, 2017.

You arrived precisely at 3:00 p.m. and proceeded to sign the substitution fo attorney and pick up your file.

At no time between April 21, 2017 and June 23, 2017, did you ever raise the issue of the potential conflict of interest. Between these two dates, you had ample opportunity to raise this issue and you did not.

On a different note, I found transcript from the three depositions I took at your request, and the redacted version of the transcript of Jennifer Jach. There are available for you to pick up at your earliest convenience.
